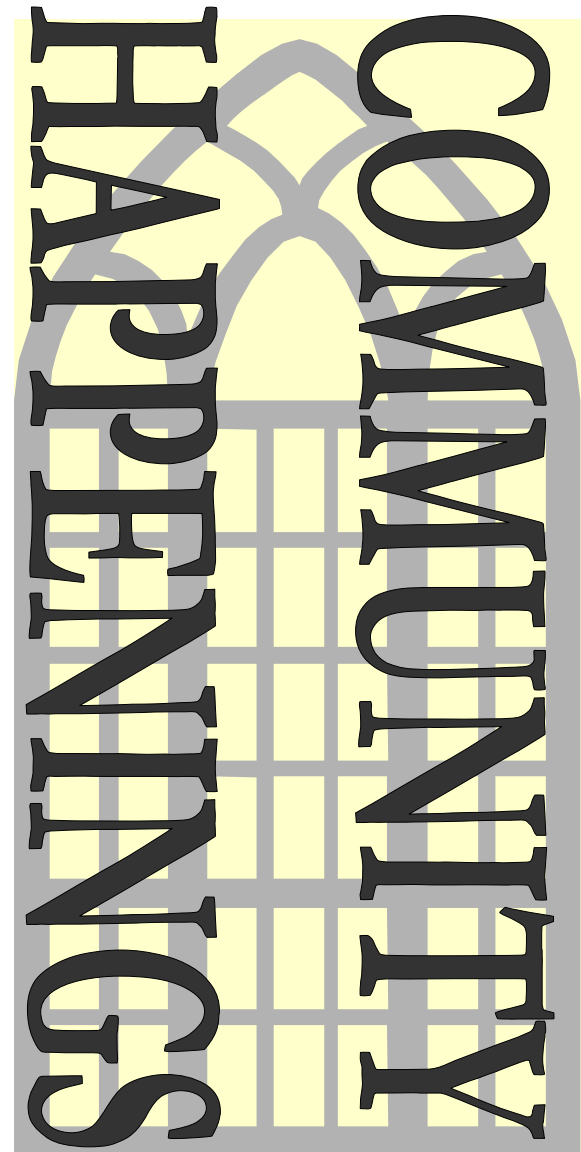

Each group consists of four couples meeting four times during the church year for dinner. We also meet all together in the fall, Christmas and during the summer. There will be a **Family Promise** training workshop for all volunteers that have interaction with Family Promise guests. This is mandatory as of 2007. This session, led by Susan Bellew, executive director of Family Promise, will be held at CPC on Sunday, September 20 at 2:00 p.m. and will last about an hour.

Interfaith Food Pantry. Please support this local pantry through your donations of sliced sandwich bread, canned fruits or vegetables, peanut butter, cereal, and jelly. The collection point is the entertainment unit across the hall from the church office. During the month of August, 8,896 pounds of food was distributed to 1,392 people in 421 families. The Food Pantry no longer accepts clothing or miscellaneous items.

A total of 209 jars of peanut butter and jelly was collected in August for the Sandhills Moore Coalition.

A 2 Cents A Meal collection will be received next **Sunday, Sept. 13.** The monies collected next Sunday will provide an opportunity for CPC to share God's love with hungry people in great need. Sixty percent of our collection will go to underdeveloped nations to feed their hungry, and forty percent will be distributed locally to agencies most in need. **2 Cents a Meal** amounts to \$1.80 a month for one person, multiplied by however many people in the household. Members of the Mission Committee will be at church exits after the service to aid with collection. Thank you for responding with gifts that will help provide sustenance and hope to people with saddened lives.
