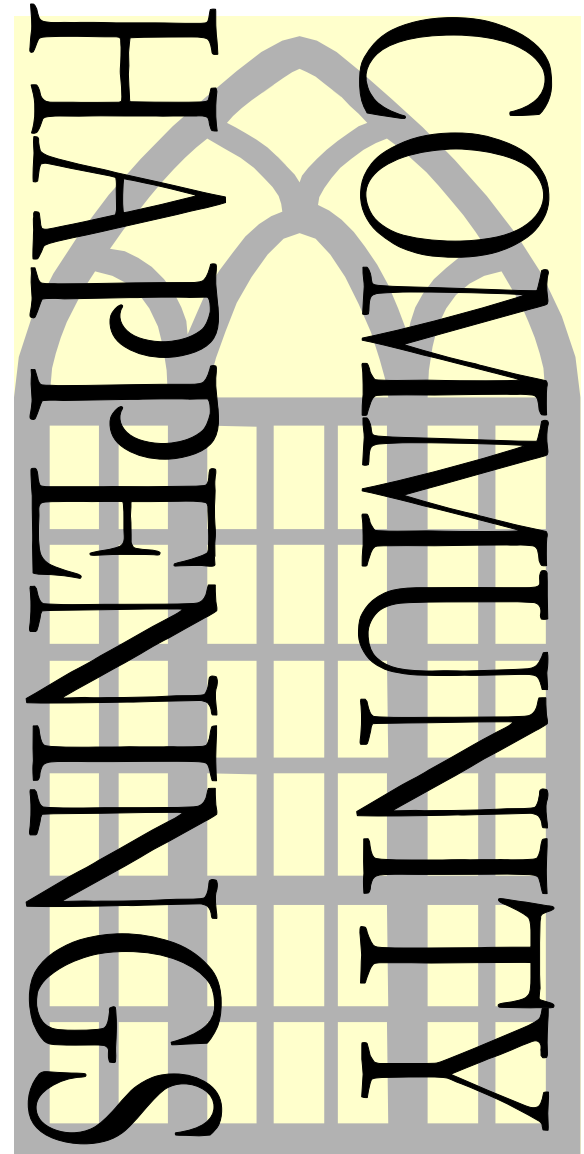

Scholarships

The **Evelyn and Monroe Diefendorf Scholarship** is offering its 9th annual scholarship. Its value is \$2,000. Eligible applicants must be members of Community Presbyterian Church. High school graduates who will be attending college in the fall may apply as well as any other church member who is currently attending college or graduate school. Previous recipients are eligible to reapply.

The **Virginia (Gini) Wessinger Memorial Scholarship** provides a \$1,000 scholarship to young persons who are planning a career in early childhood development, fine arts, nursing or teaching in these fields. Applicants from Community Presbyterian Church will be given preference. The scholarship is applicable for study at the recipient's choice of colleges.

Applications are also being received for the **Helen F. and Charles S. Millar Memorial Scholarship**. The scholarship is available to anyone who is studying nursing or medical technology at Sandhills Community College. The Millar endowment provides for a \$2000 scholarship with the potential for a \$1000 in the second year of study. Our church members will be given preference.

Applications are now available in the church office for the **Joyce G. and Roger W. Johnson** scholarship. This full scholarship is open to any Community Presbyterian Church member, regardless of age or background, who has been accepted to Sandhills Community College or plans to begin a course of study there. **The deadline for completed applications is April 1, 2010.**

The **Sheila Langdon Pierce Endowment** recognizes a deserving student interested in pursuing a nursing degree. This scholarship provides up to \$1000 per year and is available to any young person that is entering (or already in) a nursing program. While preference will be given to children of members of CPC, the scholarship is also open to anyone from Moore or a surrounding county.

Selection of the recipients of these scholarships will be determined by the Scholarship Selection Committee as part of the Endowment and Special Gifts Committee and as established by the Session. Please see Sally Raynor in the office for the applications. **Applications must be submitted prior to April 1 for the Joyce G. and Roger W. Johnson scholarship while April 30th is the deadline for all other applications.**
